



## Application for copy of the Audio Recording / Transcript of Tribunal Proceedings

3. Where a patient has a new treating team, who wish to understand what was said at a previous Tribunal hearing.
4. Where the Minister for Health or Attorney General wish to exercise a right to appear at a Tribunal review under the Mental Health & Cognitive Impairment Forensic Provisions Act 2020 and wish to understand what was said at a previous Tribunal hearing.
